Mandatory Rules

To be eligible for prize money you must hold a current Triathlon Ireland race licence or a race licence for any National Federation.

Athletes must complete the Sport Ireland anti doping certificate.

(Athletes who completed the certificate within the last three years do not need to do this again)

Athlete Briefing at The Elite National Championships

All athletes competing in the Elite National Championships will receive a separate race briefing one hour before the start of their event.

Elite National Championships – ITU World Rankings

Athletes competing in the Elite National Championships are eligible to score points towards the ITU World rankings.

BMW Triathlon National Series Points

BMW Triathlon National Series points will not be awarded to participants in the Elite National Champs. If you wish to score BMW TNS points from Dublin City Triathlon you must enter the non-drafting event.

Automatic Qualification

As an Elite National Champion you automatically qualify to represent Ireland at any ITU/ETU Age Group Championship event.
