Main Duties and Responsibilities

Course Delivery

- → Deliver Triathlon Ireland's Coaching Pathway suite of courses; Tri Leader, Level 1, Level 2 and CPD courses.
- → Prepare and deliver high quality courses in accordance with the Triathlon Ireland course content.
- → Observe and evaluate coaches and provide constructive feedback.
- → Plan and facilitate group tasks to help coaches discuss, learn, challenge and share knowledge and ideas.
- → Use modern delivery methods, IT and resources to deliver the courses.

Administration

- → Engage with a coaching group prior to the course via the World Triathlon learning Hub.
- → Using the World Triathlon learning Hub monitor and support assigned coaches.
- → Marking and assessing assigned coaches coursework.
- → Ensure all paperwork is completed within the World Triathlon and Triathlon Ireland course deadlines to ensure all coaches complete the course.

Mentoring and Coach Support

- → Where required act as a mentor to coaches to support them post course.
- → Provide coaches with information and support on developing their personal coaching pathway.

Coach Education Development

- → Where required provide feedback into the Coach Developer Team to help develop Triathlon Ireland's courses.
- → Where required support Head of Education in developing CPD Modules and reviewing course content and delivery
- → Attend any Coach Developer workshops and meetings as required.

Continuous Professional Development (CPD)

- → All CD's are expected to continuously reflect on their course delivery skills and develop where necessary.
- → Attend any further training provided by Sport Ireland
- → Act as a mentor to other Coach Developer's and Coaches where required.

- → Triathlon Ireland Level 2 Coaching Course preferred.

Time Commitment

Most Triathlon Ireland courses are delivered on weekends or evenings.

Preparation and coach support leading up to and during a course is essential and a Coach Developer must be able to dedicate substantial time to this and maintain a high level of communication with Triathlon Ireland staff and course attendees.

Once assigned to a course is it the Coach Developer's responsibility to ensure they can attend all course days.

Coach Developers will be expected to deliver at least 2 courses per year.

Coach Developers will be expected to provide coach support once a course is completed where required.

Courses are held nationwide and Coach Developer's may need to travel. However, Triathlon Ireland will endeavour to allocate courses to those who live in close proximity if possible.

Coach Developer Fees and Course Details

Course Structure as below. Please note that these courses may take place over a number of weekends or several evenings. Course fees include mileage. Coach Developers course payments will commence once they are signed off by Sport Ireland Coaching.

Coach Developer Training Course | 2022/2023

The Coach Developer course is an external course delivered by Sport Ireland Coaching. The Certificate in Sports Coach Development develops the knowledge, skills and competencies needed to develop and support sports coaches as part of a National Governing Body (NGB) coach development programme. You must be available to attend all the course dates. The course is a mixed sport course with a wide variety of other National Governing Bodies attending.

Coach Developer Programme Dates (Limerick)

The programme will begin on 22nd August 2022 with the face-to-face elements taking place on the following dates:

- · 10th + 11th September
- · 8th + 9th October
- · 12th + 13th November
- · 10th + 11th December
- · 7th + 8th January 2023

Triathlon Ireland will cover the cost of the course itself and travel and accommodation for the duration of the course.

Upon completion of the Sport Ireland Coach Developer Course you will undertake a work placement with Triathlon Ireland to gain experience in course delivery and will be expected to support and deliver at a number of Triathlon Ireland coaching courses as part of the Sport Ireland Coaching programme before you are assessed and signed off to deliver courses.
