

Motions for Discussion at the Triathlon Ireland AGM

Content of Resolution

Context

In its 2022 Triathlon Race, the Carrick On Suir Triathlon Club pursued its aspiration to become the 'greenest' race in Ireland by dispensing with the issue of 'goodie' bags to all participants. This allowed the Race Entry fee to be offered at a much keener price but more importantly, it sought to reduce the impact of superfluous waste on the environment. Items such as swim hats, plastic water bottles and packaging are often used during a specific event but are then discarded immediately afterwards, generating waste that may not find its way into the recycling chain. An opportunity exists for Triathlon Ireland to reduce the potential negative impact on our environment both during the conduct of sanctioned events and club activities.

That Triathlon Ireland incorporates an Environmental Awareness dimension to its Strategic Plan, incentivising initiatives taken by Triathlon Clubs and Race Organisers to reduce potential negative impact on our environment.
