

2024 Triathlon Ireland Nomination & Election Procedures

The Triathlon Ireland Board vacancy for election in 2024 is the Vice President role.

The Board, in advance of the nomination of any person for the position of Vice President, set out the skill sets that, in the view of the Board, the Vice President should hold.

Election Process:

1. Each Member will have one (1) vote for the election of each position.
2. There shall be no proxy votes.
3. The President has the right to cast a deciding vote at General Meetings in the case of a tie.
4. No members of the Board shall represent their own member club as a voting delegate.
5. A person may hold only one office
6. The order of elections at Annual General Meeting is:
 - a. Vice President
7. All candidates for election must:
 - a. Be nominated by Member of TI in good standing
 - b. Be individuals at least 18 years of age
8. Election procedures,
 - Each Member will have one (1) vote.
 - Each Member will have one vote for the election of each position.
 - There shall be no proxy votes.
 - Electronic voting through a Board approved voting system will be accepted at General Meetings. No postal/fax or email voting will be accepted.
 - The President (or the Vice President chairing the General Meeting in the absence of the President) has the right to cast a deciding vote at General Meetings in the case of a tie.
 - No members of the Board shall represent their own member club as a voting delegate.
 - A person may hold only one office
9. Candidates with the most votes will be elected until all Board positions are covered, with an exception when the regional and gender requirements are not covered. In these cases, the elected candidate will be the one with the most votes, who fulfills the regional and/or gender requirements.
