HOW TO RECOGNISE AND REPORT A CONCERN

WHAT SHOULD YOU REPORT?

Any Child Welfare or Safeguarding concerns whether in or outside of sport, new or old.

Any incidents of poor practice which contravene our codes of conduct in relation to children or vulnerable adults. Incidents of racism or discrimination.

You can speak to your Club Children's Officer, Club Designated Liaison Person or report directly to Triathlon Ireland via the new [online report form](#).

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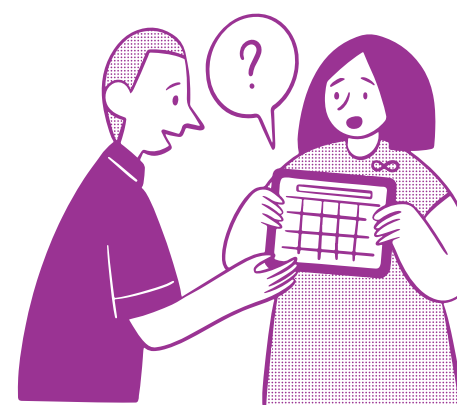
WHO SHOULD YOU REPORT TO?

The PSNI/ An Garda Síochána if a child or vulnerable person is in immediate danger. Triathlon Ireland National Children's Officer.
