I have been the Ordinary Director based in Munster for the past 4 years and would like to continue this role for a second term. During the first term I was appointed the Safeguarding Champion primarily due to my experience as a Primary school Principal.

I did my first Multi-sport event in Florida in 1994, and have loved it ever since. I moved to Ireland in 2001 and just recently became an Irish citizen. In 2004 I participated in the Fastnet Triathlon which I have been the race director of for the past 6 years. I have held different roles on the Schull Triathlon Club over the years including Chairperson, Child protection officer, and treasurer.

I raced Age Group for Ireland in the EU championships Duathlon 2011.

The same year I also started as a Technical official For TI, mostly officiating at small races. In 2013 I was a TO for the ETU junior EU Cup in Athlone, this inspired me to further my Technical official education. I am now one of only two Irish level 2 ITU TO's and have officiated at many international events including Hamburg ITU world series and ITU World Triathlon Grand Final in Lausanne. I was asked to take on the role of Munster TO Secretary in 2014, and have been responsible for running TO Courses and allocating TO's for all races in Munster ever since.

In 2018 I became a mentor for TI's new TO's and coaches.

I think I bring a lot of experience to the table and after 27 years in multisport I still have a love of this sport.


