

Position: Member of the Triathlon Ireland Technical Committee

Responsible to: Technical Committee Chair

Triathlon Ireland is the governing body for the sport of triathlon in Ireland. It is a member of World Triathlon (TRI) and is recognised by the TRI and the Sport Ireland & Sport Northern Ireland as the National Federation representing Triathlon. Triathlon Ireland's national calendar of approximately 200 sanctioned events is offered to full and one day members each year.

Triathlon Ireland's national technical program ensures that races are safe and fair for members and participants. The Technical Committee supports the development of Triathlon, Paratriathlon and its Related Multisports.

Triathlon Ireland is looking to appoint committee members to the Technical Official Committee. The Technical Committee's purpose is to support the development of the sport in Ireland and work with our Events team to deliver fun, fair and safe events. **Previous Technical Official experience is not required for this role.**

Committee Obligations

Its duties are to:

- Making recommendations to the board about Technical Official Programme Budget,
 Strategic Plan and progress against Annual Operational Plan
- Receive quarterly reports from the TI Programme Executive against Operational and Strategic Targets
- Prepare resolutions concerning amendments to TI Competition Rules for Board approval
- Nominate Technical Officials for official World Triathlon competitions for Board approval
- Advise on curriculum & examinations for the Triathlon Ireland Technical Official Education Programme
- Continue to implement tools and build partnerships between technical officials and race organisers

- Review impact of proposed international changes on conduct of competition and recommend rule changes for Board approval
- Advise the Triathlon Ireland Board and Staff Team on technical matters and respond to requests from the Triathlon Ireland Board
- Advise on providing Officials for Triathlon Ireland Sanctioned Events
- Promote the welfare and development of Officials;
- Advise and approve a specific quality assurance process for officiating at major and national events (including disciplinary procedures). ensure that the decisions of the Board are fully, promptly and properly carried out;

- Strong interpersonal, communication and negotiation skills and the ability to develop effective, sustainable partnerships;
